

## FIA ANTI DOPING ASNs OBLIGATIONS

## BACKGROUND

A new version of the World Anti-Doping Code came into effect on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2021. Accordingly, the FIA, as a signatory to the WADA Code, amended the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations to incorporate the new 2021 WADA Code.

The FIA Anti-Doping Regulations are comprised in Appendix A to the FIA International Sporting Code, which are available on the FIA website at the following address:

## ASNS' OBLIGATIONS AS REGARDS THE FIGHT AGAINST DOPING

ASNs are accountable for assisting in the fight against doping and for ensuring appropriate anti-doping measures are in place in their respective jurisdictions.

## As an ASN, your obligations are:

- To adopt and implement anti-doping policies and rules which conform with the 2021 WADA Code and International Standards as well as with the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations (Appendix A of the FIA International Sporting Code)
- To include in your policies, rules and programs the provisions necessary to ensure that the FIA may enforce the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations directly in respect of Drivers and other persons (coaches, doctors) under your anti-doping authority
- By adopting these Anti-Doping Regulations and incorporating them into your governing documents and rules of sport, you shall cooperate with and support the FIA in that function. You shall also recognize, abide by and implement the decisions made pursuant to these Anti-Doping Regulations, including the decisions imposing sanctions on persons under your authority
- To enforce compliance with the WADA Code, its International Standards and the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations

- To establish rules requiring each Driver and Driver Support Personnel preparing for or participating in a Competition or activity authorised or organised by your ASN to agree to be bound by the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations and to submit to the Results Management authority as a condition of such participation
- To report any information that suggests or relates to an anti-doping rule violation to the FIA and to your NADO, and to cooperate with any investigations conducted by any entity with authority to do so
- To have disciplinary rules in place to prevent Driver Support Personnel who are using Prohibited Substances or Prohibited Methods without justification from providing support to Drivers
- To conduct educational activities in coordination with your NADO and the FIA. The FIA shall work with you to support the implementation of your Education plans and provide assistance, information and Education resources and/or programs.
