




CIRCUIT MAP


LAS VEGAS STRIP CIRCUIT™ DETAILS

Start-to-Finish

The 3.8-mile (6,201-meter) Las Vegas Strip Circuit™ starts and finishes at Grand Prix Plaza, a 39-acre complex housing the Las Vegas Grand Prix Pit Building, a state-of-the-art, 300,000-square-foot facility that spans the length of three American football fields. Fans in the Paddock Club™, Heineken® Silver Main Grandstand and Skybox have prime views of the action along the start-finish straight, including pre-race ceremonies on the grid, the exhilarating "lights out" start, and the checkered flag after 50 thrilling laps.

Turn 1

Located just 218 yards (200 meters) from the starting grid, the hairpin Turn 1 witnessed opening lap drama in 2023. Red Bull's Max Verstappen grabbed the lead from pole-sitter Charles Leclerc at the start — but only after both drivers ran wide. Behind them, Fernando Alonso spun his Aston Martin in the middle of the pack and Valtteri Bottas and Sergio Perez collided. Further back, Carlos Sainz spun his Ferrari after tagging Lewis Hamilton's Mercedes.




Turns 2-4

Accelerating through this sequence, from 100 to 145 mph (160 to 233 kph), the track weaves left then right around Turn 3 Club before the short straight down Koval Lane. Drivers shift from third to sixth gear through this sequence. Last year, Lewis Hamilton executed a daring early-race pass around the outside of Yuki



Tsunoda's AlphaTauri here. Following the exit of Turn 4 is the first of two DRS zones, which races past the South Koval Zone by Heineken® and the Flamingo Zone by Caesars Rewards further down the straight.




Turn 5G

At the end of the Koval Straightaway, drivers brake sharply for the second gear, 65 mph (104 kph) right-hander of Turn 5G, as the drivers enter the festival-like atmosphere of the T-Mobile Zone at Sphere. Spectators in the grandstands at Turn 5G saw Alex Albon hit the wall in FP3 last year, bringing out the red flag. Brave drivers can complete an overtake into the left-hander. McLaren's Oscar Piastri made a bold pass on Pierre Gasly's Alpine for third place after a Safety Car restart on Lap 29 of the Grand Prix.



Turns 6-8


Fans in the T-Mobile Zone at Sphere will watch cars accelerate into the long left-hander at Turn 6, reaching eighth gear at speeds approaching 160 mpg (257 kph). The slow-speed Turn 7-8 chicane follows, where mistakes are common as it's difficult for drivers to pick out the braking point. Esteban Ocon is one of the few who made a successful overtake here, overtaking Logan Sargeant on the inside for sixth place on lap 14.





Turn 9

Drivers exit Turn 9 and accelerate onto Sands Avenue under the glow of Exosphere, which displayed a checkered flag animation on the final lap in 2023. During the inaugural race, Lewis Hamilton made a move past a struggling Alex Albon at Turn 9 during an entertaining scrap for 11th place.




Turns 10-11

These corners are taken flat-out in eighth gear, snaking between legendary Las Vegas resorts Wynn Las Vegas and The Venetian. At Turn 11's apex, speeds reach approximately 180 mph (289 kph) before drivers brake hard for the left-hander at Turn 12, just before turning onto the iconic Las Vegas Boulevard.



Turn 12

In 2023, the Safety Car was deployed after just three racing laps when Lando Norris made a mistake and lost control of his McLaren on the approach to his quick left-hander. Later, Max Verstappen and George Russell collided, causing another Safety Car deployment. A good exit from this turn is critical for the long blast down The Strip that follows.





Turn 13

The high-speed kink of Turn 13, located a third of the way down the neon-lit Strip, precedes the second DRS zone on the circuit. Dazzling landmarks like the Flamingo, The Fountains of Bellagio and the Paris adorn the straight that follows Turn 13. Fans in the Caesars Palace Experience will witness the fastest section of the circuit here, as cars blast by at speeds exceeding 210 mph (337 kph).



Turn 14

Turn 14 witnessed several scraps for the lead during the inaugural race. On lap 16, Ferrari's Charles Leclerc overtook Max Verstappen for first place at Turn 14. On lap 32, Sergio Perez passed Leclerc for the lead — only for the Ferrari driver to reclaim it back three laps later. Finally, Verstappen retook P1 from Leclerc on lap 37 to secure victory in the inaugural Las Vegas race. But Turn 14 had one final twist, when Leclerc made a thrilling last-lap pass on Sergio Perez to secure second place to the delight of the onlooking fans. Leclerc experienced 5.02G in deceleration force during the lunge, earning the 2023 Overtake of the Year.



Turns 15-16


After Turn 14, drivers navigate two more apexes before the short sprint along East Harmon Avenue towards the final corner. In 2023, Lewis Hamilton and Oscar Piastri made contact here and both picked up tire punctures. With the pit lane entrance situated just after the West Harmon Grandstand, it was on this approach that Piastri littered the track in a shower of sparks in his attempt to pit for a fresh set of tires.





Turn 17

The final corner of the Las Vegas Strip Circuit™ is a flat-out, left-hander taken at full throttle at 195 mph (313 kph). Lewis Hamilton made an audacious overtake here, going wheel-to-wheel through the apex alongside Pierre Gasly's Alpine, securing ninth place just five laps before the checkered flag.

Language

Time Zone

- + Las Vegas, Nevada is in the Pacific Time Zone (GMT-7)

Currency

That national currency of Las Vegas, Nevada is the American Dollar (USD) and supplied by the U.S. Federal Reserve. American paper currency come in seven denominations: \$1, \$2, \$5, \$10, \$20, \$50, and \$100.

ATM & Credit Card Information — ATMs in Casinos

Credit Cards are widely accepted around Las Vegas. ATMs are readily available, although ATM Fees are much higher inside of casinos than at a bank.

Gratuities

Customarily, gratuities of 18% to 20% of the pre-tax total are paid to hospitality industry personnel who render personal services. You may find a restaurant has already added the gratuity to the bill. If you are in a larger group (usually 6+), many restaurants will automatically add a 20% gratuity to your final bill. In that case, you are not required to give any additional amount.

It is also customary to provide tips for bellmen, usually \$2 a bag, and \$2 - \$5 a day for housekeeping.

Alcohol

The legal drinking age is 21 in Nevada. Carrying an open container & consuming it in public is legal on the Strip and in Downtown Las Vegas on Fremont Street. It is prohibited to have glass containers outside of a bar or restaurant, and open containers when a passenger of a private vehicle, including rideshares.

Smoking

Smoking and vaping are not permitted in the Media Center, the Paddock and Pit Building.

Gambling

The legal gambling age in Nevada is 21. While some resorts prohibit videos and photography on the casino floor, others may allow small camera or cell phone photos. It is highly recommended that you clear any filming requests with property



public relations prior to arrival. 1-800-GAMBLER is the 24/7 National Problem Gambling Helpline.

Electricity

The standard voltage is 120 V and the standard frequency is 60 Hz. In the U.S., the power plugs and sockets are of type A and B, which is the plug that has 2 rectangular pins (A) and sometimes a third circular pin (B).

Telephones

+1 is the international code used to dial to USA. Las Vegas mobile phone numbers have 10 digits and most mobile numbers start with 702 and 725. All 10 digits must be dialed for calls within Las Vegas. For example: 702-123-XXXX. When calling from outside the US, you will need to dial +1 (the US country code) + (US area code) + (7-digit US local phone number). For example: +1 702-123-XXXX.

Taxes

The minimum combined 2024 sales tax rate for Las Vegas, Nevada is 8.38%. This is the total of state, county, and city sales tax rates

Hotel Tax

In addition to a 13.38% hotel tax, there may also be additional taxes and fees charged by individual hotels, including: Resort fees – These daily mandatory fees cover amenities like internet, gym access, etc., and are typically \$20-\$50 per night.

Driving & Traffic Regulations

U.S. law stipulates driving on the right-hand side of the road and passing on the left. Right turns are permitted at red lights unless otherwise indicated. Always note posted speed limits. All persons riding in an automobile are required to wear seat belts. Children under five years of age must be fastened securely in government-approved child car seats.

GETTING AROUND LAS VEGAS

Driving & Media Parking

Parking is limited and is assigned on a first come, first-served basis. The media car park is located at the Tuscany Suites & Casino where the Media Center is located. An official car pass is needed to park there. Please inquire at the **Media Accreditation Center** for more details. Media parking is walking distance from both the Media Center and the paddock.



Rideshare

Media are highly encouraged to take rideshare to and from the Media Center and MAC daily for ease of access. Lyft and Uber are authorized to provide services at the airport and most locations around the city. Use the apps on your mobile device to arrange for a ride. New for 2024, Tuscany Suites & Casino will have a rideshare pick-up and drop-off location just steps away from the MAC and Media Center. Please put in "Tuscany Suites & Casino" into Lyft or Uber to access the Media Center and MAC.

Harry Reid International Airport (LAS)

[Harry Reid International Airport](#) is conveniently located just 2 miles from Las Vegas Boulevard and 2.4 miles from the Tuscany Suites & Casino (Media Accreditation Center and Media Center), with most hotels located within a 2 to 5-mile drive from the airport. Taxis

Taxis are a reliable form of transportation used throughout Las Vegas. Taxi service is regulated by the [Nevada Taxicab Authority](#), a Nevada State agency responsible for issuing medallions and setting fares. There are [several companies](#) to choose from and taxis are available. Unlike other cities, you cannot hail a taxi on the street in Las Vegas. Taxis are required to pick up passengers at a physical address, such as a hotel taxi line. Hotels have specific areas for taxi pick-up, usually near the valet or main entrance. Taxis are common around Las Vegas and queue at most major resort casinos. All taxi companies accept credit cards. The maximum number of passengers allowed in any cab is six.

Las Vegas Monorail

With trains arriving every 5-10 minutes at seven stations spanning the east-side of the Las Vegas Strip, the [Las Vegas Monorail](#) is a convenient, cost-effective option to navigate the Strip corridor. The Las Vegas Monorail offers [mobile tickets](#) and several [fare types](#) to suit travel needs, from a one-way trip to an unlimited-ride pass. The Monorail operates from 7AM on November 19 to 3AM on November 25, with tickets available for purchase at the stations or online.



MAIN RULES & REGULATIONS IN FORMULA ONE

A Concise Summary

General Provisions

Both cars entered by a competitor must be presented in substantially the same livery at every Competition, any significant change to this livery during a championship may only be made with the agreement of the FIA and the Commercial Rights Holder.

In order that the cars of each competitor may be easily distinguished from one another whilst they are on the track, the on-board cameras located above the principal roll structure of the first car must remain as it is supplied to the Competitor and the second car must be predominantly fluorescent yellow.

Each car will carry the competition number of its driver as published by the FIA at the beginning of the championship or the competition number that has been allocated to his replacement in accordance with Article 32.4c). This number must be clearly visible from the front of the car and on the driver's crash helmet.

Scrutineering

Each competitor will be required to carry out initial scrutineering of his cars which will commence four hours prior to the start of P1 and submit the duly completed declaration no later than two hours before the start of P1.

Event Schedule

At each competition where a sprint session is not scheduled:

Two free practice sessions (P1 and P2), each lasting one hour and separated by no less than two hours and no more than three hours, take place on the first day of on track running.

Within three hours of the end of the second free practice session (P2) all cars used during each session (or which were intended for use but failed to leave the pit lane) must be covered and ready for FIA seals to be applied in order to ensure that they remain secure until the following day.

A further free practice session (P3), lasting one hour and starting no less than eighteen hours after the end of P2, will take place on the second day of on track running. Three hours before the start of P3, the FIA seals and covers may be removed.



The starting grid of the race will be determined by the results of the qualifying practice session which will take place on the second day of on track running, and will start no less than two hours, and no more than three hours after the end of P3.

Qualifying

The qualifying practice session will be run as follows:

For the first eighteen minutes of the session (Q1) all cars will be permitted on the track and at the end of this period the slowest five cars will be prohibited from taking any further part in the session. Lap times achieved by the fifteen remaining cars will then be deleted. The eliminated five cars make up grid positions 20 to 16.

After a seven-minute break the session will resume for fifteen minutes (Q2) and the fifteen remaining cars will be permitted on the track. At the end of this period the slowest five cars will be prohibited from taking any further part in the session. Lap times achieved by the ten remaining cars will then be deleted. The eliminated five cars will make up grid positions 15 to 11.

After an eight-minute break the session will resume for twelve minutes (Q3) and the ten remaining cars will be permitted on the track. The remaining ten cars will make up grid positions 10 to 1.

Each car will be deemed to be in parc fermé from the time at which it leaves the pit lane for the first time during the qualifying practice session until the start of the race. Any car which fails to leave the pit lane during the qualifying practice session will be deemed to be in parc fermé at the end of Q1. Between these times, other than when cars are sealed overnight, a certain amount of work may be carried out.

Race

When the green lights are illuminated, all cars on the grid should begin the formation lap with the pole position driver leading. When leaving the grid all drivers must respect the pit lane speed limit until they pass pole position. Marshals will be instructed to push any car (or cars) which remain on the grid into the pit lane by the fastest route immediately after cars able to do so have left the grid. Any driver being pushed from the grid may not attempt to start the car and must follow the instructions of the marshals.

During the formation lap practice starts are forbidden and the formation must be kept as tight as possible. Overtaking during the formation lap is only permitted if a car is delayed and cars behind cannot avoid passing it without unduly delaying the remainder of the field. In this case, drivers may only overtake to re-establish the original starting order.



Any driver delayed in this way, and who is unable to re-establish the original starting order before he reaches the first safety car line, must enter the pit lane and start from the end of the pit lane.

When the cars come back to the grid at the end of the formation lap or laps, they must stop within their respective starting grid positions, keeping their engines running. There will be a standing start, the signal being given by means of lights activated by the permanent starter. Once all the cars have come to a halt the five-second light will appear followed by the four, three, two and one second lights. At any time after the one-second light appears, the race will be started by extinguishing all red lights.

A chequered flag will be the end-of-session signal and will be shown at the Line as soon as the leading car has covered the full distance.

The car placed first will be the one having covered the scheduled distance in the shortest time, or, where appropriate, passed the line in the lead at the end of two hours. All cars will be classified taking into account the number of complete laps they have covered, and for those which have completed the same number of laps, the order in which they crossed the line. Cars having covered less than 90% of the number of laps covered by the winner (rounded down to the nearest whole number of laps), will not be classified.

Safety Car

The safety car may be brought into operation to neutralize a race upon the order of the clerk of the course. It will be used only if competitors or officials are in immediate physical danger on or near the track but the circumstances are not such as to necessitate suspending the race.

Virtual Safety Car Procedure (VSC)

The VSC procedure may be initiated to neutralize a practice session or a race upon the order of the clerk of the course. It will normally be used when double waved yellow flags are needed on any section of track and competitors or officials may be in danger, but the circumstances are not such as to warrant use of the safety car itself.



Points

Points for both titles will be awarded at each competition according to the following scale.

In addition to the above, one point will be awarded to the driver who achieved the fastest valid lap time of the race and to the constructor whose car he was driving, provided he was in the top ten positions of the final race classification. No point will be awarded if the fastest valid lap time is achieved by a driver who was classified outside the top ten positions, or if the leader has completed less than 50% of the scheduled race distance.

Tires

Although Pirelli provides three compounds – the softs, mediums, and hards – for every race, there are six tire compounds available that differ between events. The hardest of these six compounds is the C0, the second-hardest the C1, etc. until reaching the C5, the softest tire in the current F1 range.

For easier identification, the tire walls have a colored band on each side, with red denoting soft tires, yellow indicating mediums, and the white-walled tires are the hards. Green-walled tires (intermediate) are for damp conditions and blue (full wet) for heavy rain. Colors remain the same for each race despite different compounds being used.

Every driver must use at least two tire compounds during a race, unless the race is declared wet. Pirelli provides 13 sets of tires for each driver for the weekend, divided into eight sets of soft tires, three sets of mediums, and two sets of hards. Additionally, each driver gets four sets of intermediate tires for damp tracks and three sets of full wets for heavy rain.

After every free practice session, a driver must return two sets of tires to Pirelli, so by the time Qualifying begins, a driver will have just seven sets of tires to make it from Q1 until the race's chequered flag.

To give a slight advantage to drivers that don't qualify in the top 10, any driver who doesn't make Q3 will retain all seven sets of tires for the race, while P1-P10 qualifiers hand Pirelli back one final set after qualifying ends.



Sanctions

The stewards may impose the penalties specifically set out in the FIA Sporting Regulations in addition to or instead of any other penalties available to them. Any driver who receives five reprimands in the same championship will, upon the imposition of the fifth, be given a ten-grid place penalty for the race at that competition. If the fifth reprimand is imposed following an incident during a race, the ten-grid place penalty will be applied at the driver's next competition. The ten-grid place penalty will only be imposed if at least four of the reprimands were imposed for a driving infringement.
