**Subject** : Update of FIA Homologation Regulations for Circuit Equipment

We would like to inform you that, following the World Motor Sport Council meeting of 28 February 2024, the FIA Homologation Regulations for Circuit Equipment has been updated. The latest version has been published on the FIA website, and can be downloaded **HERE**.

The updates are focused on aligning the re-homologation process for circuit equipment with the process in place for safety equipment.

This updated process will allow the manufacturers to opt between applying for a re-homologation, either with a new test report according to the specific FIA standard they are applying for, or by submitting the quality control requirements for the specific FIA standard. These changes will allow a smoother and seamless process for circuit equipment manufacturers.

Manufacturers must immediately cease using the FIA Label and FIA Holograms (where applicable) once the homologation validity has expired.

If a test performed for continuous quality control or in an FIA-approved test house for the re-homologation test report is not passed, the FIA must be informed immediately. Furthermore, if the manufacturer becomes aware of any non-compliance with the standard to which the sample is homologated, the manufacturer must inform the FIA immediately.
